The project aims to produce three main tools to help reach this aim

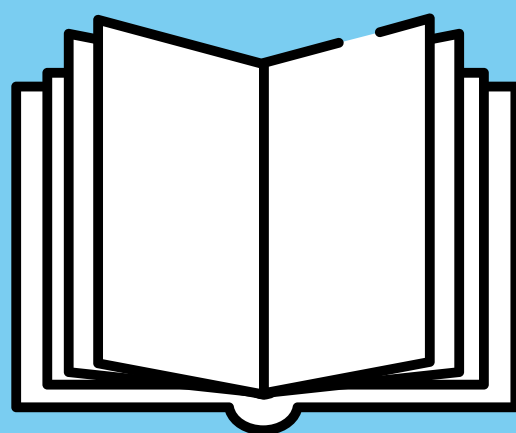


E-PRIVACING ROADMAP
